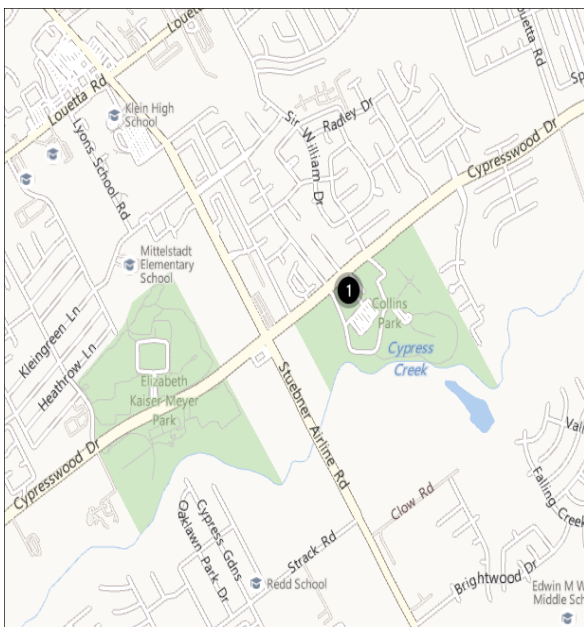


Scheduled Activities

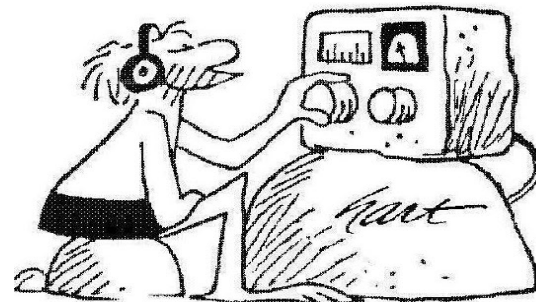
