What is ARRL Field Day?



ARRL is the American Radio Relay League. Founded in 1914, the ARRL is the national association for amateur radio in the US. Today, with more than 161,000 members, ARRL is the largest organization of radio amateurs in the United States and the primary source of information about what is going on in the ham radio world.

Field Day is THE premiere annual amateur radio exercise encouraging emergency communications preparedness among amateur radio operators. ARRL Field Day is the most popular on-the-air event held annually in the US and Canada. On the fourth weekend of June, rain or shine, more than 35,000 radio amateurs gather with their clubs, groups or simply with friends to operate and practice emergency preparedness communications.

Field Day is always a popular event with NARS members. This event is open to the General Public and ALL amateur radio operators.

NARS is the Northwest Amateur Radio Society and was established in 1985. NARS serves northwest Harris County. We participate in community and public service events.
