Fire Chief Visits NARS

Fred Windisch gave a talk on fire safety and how Hams are contributing to the local fire districts. Fred Talked for about one hour with no notes, and no power point slides. It was one of the best presentation in a long while. He explained how and which local Fire districts are rated in relation to a national rating system. Ponderosa Fire District is rated 3 as is the Kline Fire District with the Tomball Fire District taking first place as a #1. This rating system has a lot to do with the cost of our homeowner's insurance fees. As a 3 we can save as much as \$60 to \$100 per year. He also explained that with the size of the districts his fire department covers 350 square miles and about 750,000 people. Today departments are a mix of full time paid firefighters, and a volunteer staff which shows up in our tax rate. His object is to save houses not just foundations. He also talked about the new EMS Emergency Communication Command Center that just became operational. The new EMS Comm Center covers 13 different fire districts. It was a very informative program.
