New Meeting Location



President's Corner

Richard Nelson, KF5WRD—October 2018

This past year has been a year of changes and hurdles for both Houston and NARS. While some changes cause anguish, other changes can be good. Change is part of life, and this is true again this month.

Hurricane Harvey created numerous changes, including to damage to some member's homes, and to our meeting place. Other members have moved on or become SK. Another ongoing issue is the club's 2m repeater. Partly in response to these various changes, other aspects of the club have changed as well. Changes to the weekly net; the practice of having coffee and cookies at the meetings, and the regularity of dinner before meetings, come to mind.

One of our most significant changes was the loss of our meeting place at the after the Harvey flooding. As a result, the club meeting location was floating for a bit. Thanks to Keith Dutson, NM5G, who arranged for us to use Spring Creek barbecue. This location worked for several months but was not ideal. Thanks in part to Jerry Whiting KB5VGD, we eventually moved into the facility at the Ponderosa Fire Station – thanks to their generosity for hosting us. It now appears that the club will move again starting with the November meeting – read on.

One positive change this past year was that several of our members became very active in DMR and Digital Radio. Marty Fitzgerald W5MF, Walter Holmes K5WH, and Ron Matusek WA6TQH, on their own initiative, developed a series of DMR training classes. The response from other area clubs was so great it became necessary to move the classes from our Ponderosa Fire location. Through the involvement of Mike Pace, K5MAP, the Klein Fire District allowed use of their Administrative Services Building. This has opened a new opportunity.

One positive outcome was several new members joined NARS while others renewed during these classes. Also, beginning in November, the monthly NARS meeting will move to the Klein Fire District Administrative Services Building located behind Klein Station 4. 18610 Squires Rd [South of the Klein Post Office on Louetta]. This location is closer to our former location and has more available parking than the current Ponderosa station.

On another front we have had some personnel changes. First, I need to mention again the recent loss of Joe Sokolowski, KD5KR. Joe's move to Abilene and subsequent passing this past April made it clear just how much he was doing for NARS as Administrative Secretary.

Which brings me to the next item, Keith Dutson who was already the Vice President took over the Admin Secretary duties as well. Keith has been wearing many hats and has been Johnny-on-the-Spot for numerous club functions, including VE Coordinator and managing the Texas QSO party which NAR sponsors. This past month Keith resigned from the Vice President position and the Administrative Secretary position. I want to publicly thank Keith for carrying the so many club functions on his shoulders.

Keith's leaving created a void. During the September meeting, several temporary appointments were made, which I will describe below. The club by-laws state that elections are to be held at the next meeting after required notification has been given. The Board determined as elections were already scheduled for November that the actual election will be held then, with the October meeting serving as notification to members.

Because several Board Members stepped into temporary roles, this created several immediate vacancies on the Board.

The club needs new blood and new ideas. When elections come this November, the club will have several openings, including the Board spots. I would like to devote some time at the beginning of the October meeting to getting a slate of candidates for various open positions. The November newsletter will announce candidates for the positions.

Another change made by the Board to encourage more participation and member input, is to start holding Board meetings prior to the general meetings. Beginning with our November meeting, starting at 6 pm at the Squires location.

Finally, I plan to step down as President. The acting Vice President, Ron Matusek is willing to become President, but this is subject to confirmation vote by the members. I also wish to state that I'm willing to serve as a Board Member, if elected. If not, I will be happy to help with any transition going forward. I would like to urge all interested and active NARS members to attend the next meetings, in October because balloon launches are cool and in November because NARS needs you.
