
We will meet at Klein Fire Department Administration, 16810 Squyres Rd., Klein, TX 77379. It is located behind Klein Fire Station 4.



Officers election process for November 2020 in-person and Zoom meeting.

In-person voters.

- 1. Will ask for ID/KEY from Administrator (Sam Labarbera.)
- 2. The person will receive a Voter ID and Voter Key.

3. The voter can take the Voter ID/KEY and use a Phone, iPad, Laptop, or Tablet to vote. The URL is: https://j.mp/3iURxvd or https://narstexas.electionrunner.com. There should be a laptop or other device in the meeting venue available for those to vote who's device is not adequate for some reason.

Remote voters.

- 1. Each voter with receive an email at the address registered in the NARS database.
- 2. The email will have a Voter ID and Voter Key and a link directly to the voting web site.
- 3. Help will be available on the normal meeting Zoom channel during the voting process.

Common instructions.

- 1. Each voter will have to vote for the proper number of candidates in each race. If a candidate is unopposed a vote is required before the voter can move to the next race.
- 2. If a race has more candidates that positions to fill then the voter with be instructed on how many candidates to choose for that race. To make a change in selection first one of the selections must be undone and a new selection can then be made.
- 3. The votes cast are secret. NO ONE can see who anyone cast their votes for. The only information available will be a total number of votes cast for each candidate.
- 4. At the conclusion of the election process the vote tallies will be made public.
