

Repeater Update—July 4, 2021

Below is information on NARS repeaters that are available for you to use.

Please use them, especially the new linked system in Klein. For now, please continue using K5WH 146.76 offset minus .600 PL Tone 103.5 for the Wednesday night net till we get the linking system up on the new downtown location. W5NC-R Echolink/Allstar will be pointed to the New NARS Repeaters normally, but will be switched to K5WH repeater for the Wednesday night net only.

Current production repeaters. Plan is that these will be put in standby as backups later or possibly replaced as newer repeater come online:

- 1. Galleria 146.660 offset minus .600 PL Tone 141.3 <-- Very Noisy repeater, but usable inside the 610 loop.
- 2. Galleria 444.375 offset plus 5.00 PL Tone 103.5 <-- Low power but usable. Might replace with multimode repeater for DMR, D-Star, and YSF.

New NARS Repeaters:

- 1. Klein area 444.375 offset plus 5.00 PL Tone 100.0 <-- This system is up and working very well in the Klein area. Please use it anytime.
- 2. *At my home in the Klein area 146.660 offset minus .600 Tone 100.0 <-- This system is in test mode and is linked to the Klein 444.375 repeater. If you can hit this system please go ahead, but be aware I might be working on this system. In all cases I will announce when I am programming it. This system has the old Klein VFD repeater, a UHF linking transceiver, and the ARCOM RC-210. Voice announcements about current club activities will be automatically transmitted here. If you listen, you will even hear my 9 year old and 7 year old granddaughters ID'ing the W5NC club call. This system will be going to the new downtown location on top of a very tall building.

*John Parmalee, K5VGM is in current negotiations with the building management right now for the new downtown location.
