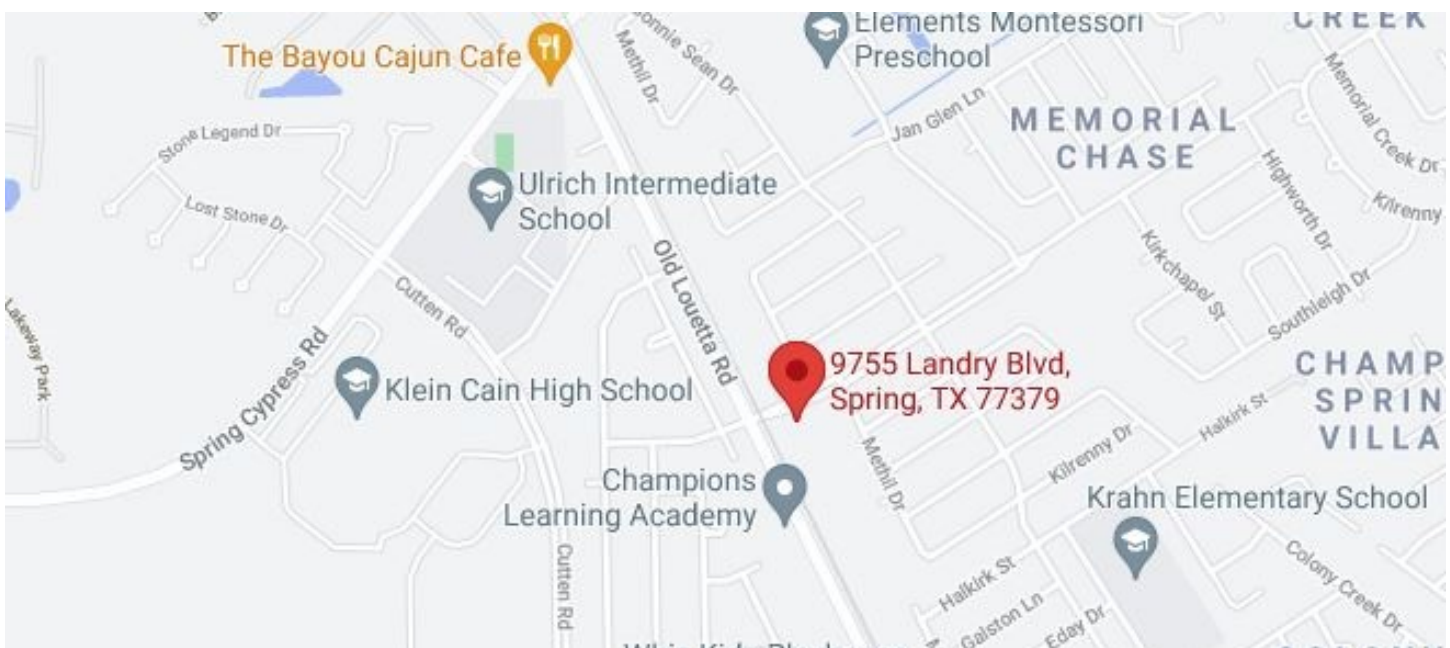

Bylaws revision

In the past couple of months the board has been considering updating our club by-laws to reflect current practices. It is our intent to have more members involved in club responsibilities and yet to realize that as the environment around us changes and needs of the community change we need to be flexible to meet those ongoing needs. It should be understood that the Constitution and By-Laws are living documents and are subject to updates from time to time as the current administration sees a need to make changes.

Some of the highlights covered in this update are as follows:

1. Reduce the number of elected voting board members. Those members who will be voting going forward in this release are: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasure, Director #1 & Director #2.

2. We have established general guidelines and responsibilities for Associate Director and Ad-Hoc committee positions. These positions are non-voting positions and are appointed by the President after consultation with the Elected board members.

- a. Administrative Secretary
- b. Newsletter Editor
- c. Webmaster
- d. VEC Liaison
- e. Repeater Team
- f. Call sign and Repeater Trustee
- g. Field Day Coordinator
- h. Public Information Liaison
- i. Network Control Team
- j. Nominating Committee
- k. Social Media Coordinator
- l. Special and Ad Hoc Committees
- m. Officer vacancies

3. Any member in good standing as described in the Bylaws is eligible to hold office in the club provided that the member does not hold office in any other Amateur Radio service club. Members holding an office in the American Radio Relay League (ARRL) are exempt from this restriction.

4. Office terms: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasure will be elected to two year terms.. Director #1 and Director #2 will be elected to ONE year terms.

The documents have been processed through couple rigorous weeks of review and changes based on the input received from ALL board members and has been approved by the Elected Voting board members. These documents are now available to the entire club membership of record for your review. We expect to have a membership vote on final adoption of these documents during the month of September via a ZOOM session to be announced later. Unfortunately in-person meetings are on hold do to increased health concerns.

Final note. All current Officer and Director positions will continue to serve in the elected positions. The changes announced here will take effect in January as is our custom.

Please take the time to read these documents carefully and be prepared for an UP or DOWN vote in September.
